- 4. Challenge entrenched racism and power imbalances in philanthropy.

Let Us Breathe Fund

- Founded in 2015 following the murder of Eric Garner.
- The only NYC fund led by and for Black communities organizing around police reform and building Black liberation.
- The Fund supports the long-term
 leadership of Black New Yorkers
 fighting state violence and
 structural racism.
- We've awarded over \$1M to 35+ groups.




Transformative Justice

A community-based strategy for responding to harm outside of the criminal legal system. TJ recognizes that interpersonal harm is rooted in oppression and works to change conditions that create, maintain, sustain, and support oppression, exploitation, domination and harm.

TJ/CA links justice for individuals and social justice by recognizing oppression and privilege and its effects on the survivor and the person who caused harm. TJ/CA works to meet individual needs for justice (safety, healing, repair, connection accountability) while also working towards a long term vision for liberation.

Examples: accountability processes, neighborhood based safety projects



Provide SAFETY & SUPPORT to community members who are violently targeted that RESPECTS THEIR SELF-DETERMINATION Create and affirm VALUES & PRACTICES that resist abuse and oppression and encourage safety, support, and accountability

> - COMMUNITY -ACCOUNTABILITY

Commit to ongoing development of all members of the community, and the community itself, to TRANSFORM THE POLITICAL CONDITIONS that reinforce oppression and violence

Develop sustainable strategies to ADDRESS COMMUNITY MEMBERS' ABUSIVE BEHAVIOR,

to account for their actions and transform their behavior
